- CAO Bogle asked that by law, part of it allows you to demolish the property at your own cost, are you able to do that? To which Carol MacLean responded that she cannot as she is retired now and in the process of paying back CRA for the last two years of taxes.

- Not at this time but CAO Dale Bogle and Mayor George Lloy have agreed to help by bringing her out and helping her.
